Heart For The Fatherless is excited to announce a key element of our adoption ministry; Alongside Fundraising! Fundraising can often be one of the most overwhelming parts of the adoption process. As such, we would like to try and make things a bit easier for local Christian families. To do this, we will be holding several big events throughout the year in which families can apply for sponsorship. Our winter event will be a Night of Wishes fundraiser. We will be sponsoring one Christian family at this event and would like to give local Christian families an opportunity to apply for sponsorship. The chosen Christian family will be based on need and preferential treatment will be given to those that have not yet completed their home study process, but we encourage all interested families to apply!

Here is how this event will work: We will be hosting a Night of Wishes event in which we will be launching hundreds of Chinese lanterns! This event will occur on January 21<sup>st</sup> from 7pm-9pm at the Calvary Chapel Amphitheater in Kennewick, Wa. Sponsored families will be required to sell as many tickets to this event as they can. Our goal is to sell a minimum of 200 lanterns! In addition to sending off our lanterns, we are also working to get some pre-launch entertainment from a local Chinese dance group. (I am working out the details with them now.)

Families will have the choice of several levels of participation/donating. These include the following:

\$10—With this level of donation, the family will receive one lantern, 4 cookies, and 4 cups of cider.

\$20—With this level of donation, the family will receive two lanterns, 6 cookies, and 6 cups of cider.

\$30—With this level of donation, the family will receive three lanterns, 8 cookies, and 8 cups of cider.

In addition, we will be holding a fortune cookie raffle for a large item (to be determined). Tickets for the raffle are \$1 each and can be pre-sold (winner does not need to be present to win!).
